## **Introductions**

### **Background & Context**

- Concentrated growth in the Newcastle area and program considerations, such as French Immersion (FI) programming, have put an increased amount of pressure on the available space at Newcastle PS.
- In September 2022, the Grade 6 students from Newcastle PS transitioned to The Pines Senior PS to alleviate accommodation pressure being felt at Newcastle PS.
- In September of 2023, FI will be phased in at The Pines Senior PS, which will increase accommodation pressures at The Pines Senior PS.
- Clarke High School has experienced a decline in enrolment.
- The Board anticipates this to be a continuous trend over the next 5 to 10 years.
- A review of this Elementary Family of Schools (EFOS) is now being conducted to explore solutions to the ongoing accommodation pressures.

### Background & Context

In February of 2022, KPR submitted a capital priorities business case for a new K-12 school at the Grady Drive/Ruddell Road property in Newcastle. The submission was not approved by the Ministry of Education. We will continue to prioritize this capital request.

Until the Board is approved for a new school in Newcastle, several strategies to reduce accommodation pressures should be considered:

- the use of additional portables,
- the establishment of holding areas,
- change in grade cohorts/program delivery between available facilities, and/or
- boundary adjustments

### Background & Context


- The Board has employed measures to manage the accommodation pressure at Newcastle PS:
  - 11 portables are presently located at Newcastle PS
  - Holding school has been established for new residential development areas.
- As Newcastle continues to grow, Planning Services staff are tasked with identifying longer term solutions to address the capacity and space limitations at Newcastle PS and The Pines Senior PS.
- Staff have completed proposed options which include program, and/or grade cohort adjustments involving Newcastle PS, The Pines Senior PS and Clarke High School (HS).

## Population Growth in Clarington

- The Province has set minimum growth targets for Clarington, as it is considered an urban growth centre.
- In order to achieve the minimum growth targets, Clarington's Official Plan (2018) sets a growth forecast of approximately 140,300 residents by 2031.
  - Growth of approximately 40,000 additional residents by 2031
- To facilitate growth, Clarington is in the process of developing 12 secondary plans, two of which are in the vicinity of Newcastle:
  - North Village Secondary Plan
  - Wilmot Creek Neighbourhood Secondary Plan


### North Village Secondary Plan


- Secondary plan is within the Newcastle PS / The Pines Sr. PS catchment.
- Preliminary student yield calculations indicate that approximately 463 elementary students; and 176 secondary students will be generated.
- A 'holding school area' has been established at Waverley PS for students generated from the development area.
- A public elementary school site (i.e., Potential North Village Option) has been identified in the approved area.



### Wilmot Creek Neighbourhood Secondary Plan

- The secondary plan is comprised of medium and high-density dwelling units.
- Preliminary student yield calculations identify that the secondary plan may generate 161 to 253 elementary students and 56 to 88 secondary students.
- It is anticipated that nearby schools, Vincent Massey Public School (current catchment) and Waverly Public School will have residual capacity to accommodate the anticipated elementary students.





## Pupil Accommodation Review (PAR)

- A Pupil Accommodation Review (PAR) is a process required by the Ministry of Education where a school closure and/or consolidation is being considered to address changing demographics, enrolment, programming, and facility condition challenges.
- Pupil Accommodation Reviews are governed by prescribed Ministry timelines and follow a Board approved policy and process.
- Since June 2017, the Ministry of Education has put a 'pause' on such reviews.

## Pupil Accommodation Review (PAR)


- The Ministry of Education PAR Guidelines (April 2018) and Board Policy BA-1.2, Pupil Accommodation Review: School Closure/Consolidation indicate that a PAR would be required if the number of students relocated is greater than 50% of the school's enrolment.
  - Given this, examples of options that the Board is unable to consider at this time include:
    - Establishment of a single-track French Immersion program at one of the schools (i.e., The Pines PS).
    - Conversion of The Pines Sr. PS to a secondary school and Clarke HS to an elementary school
- Considering the 'pause' of Pupil Accommodation Reviews as per the Ministry Guidelines, Board staff have identified several options which would not require a PAR but will assist in relieving accommodation pressures being felt in the Clarke Elementary Family of Schools.


OTG – Capacity of the school Newcastle OTG includes the six (6) permanent portables (portapak).

### Option A: Remain Status Quo



#### Newcastle PS -


- remains a dual track JK/SK-5 school
- enrolment is expected to exceed the school's capacity
- accommodation pressure cannot be effectively managed on site



### Orono PS -


- remains a JK-6 school
- enrolment is projected to remain steady slightly above the school's capacity
- accommodation pressures can be managed via portables at this site

### Option A: Remain Status Quo



### The Pines Senior PS -

- remains a dual track grades 6-8 school
- Newcastle PS and Orono PS would continue to feed into The Pines Senior PS.
- enrolment is expected to exceed the school's capacity within the 5-year projection period




#### Clarke HS -

- remains a grades 9-12 school
- The Pines Senior PS would continue to feed into Clarke HS
- Clarke HS is projected to be greatly underutilized over the 10-year projection period

## Option B: Change in grade cohort between Newcastle PS, The Pines Senior PS and Clarke HS.



### **Newcastle PS**


- becomes a dual track JK/SK-4

- in this option there is a stabilization of enrolment at The Pines Senior PS

## Option B: Change in grade cohort between Newcastle PS, The Pines Senior PS and Clarke HS.




#### Clarke HS

- a dual track intermediate school (7-8) is established at Clarke HS
- Clarke HS continues to offer grade 9 to 12
- the students can be physically separated as an intermediate and a secondary school, or the school can be established as a grade 7 to 12 school
- the physical building, Clarke HS, can accommodate additional classrooms dedicated to the new intermediate school
- enrolment levels approach the school's capacity



### **Newcastle PS**


- becomes a dual track JK/SK to 3 school
- in this option there is a stabilization of enrolment at Newcastle PS
- there would be residual capacity for students generated from the impending residential development within the Newcastle PS catchment.



### The Pines Senior PS

- becomes a dual track grade 4 to 6 school
- in this option enrolment at The Pines Senior PS will exceed its capacity within the 5-year projection period

## Option C: Change in grade cohort between Newcastle PS, The Pines Senior PS and Clarke HS.




#### **Clarke HS**



#### **Newcastle PS**


- becomes a dual track JK/SK to 4
- in this option there is a stabilization of enrolment at Newcastle PS



#### The Pines Senior PS

- becomes a dual track grade 5 to 8 school
- in this option enrolment at The Pines Senior PS will exceed its capacity within one year based on projections.

## Option D: Change in grade cohort between Newcastle PS and The Pines Senior PS



### **Clarke HS**

- Clarke HS remains status quo as a grade 9 to 12 school
- Clarke HS remains underutilized.
